

The Lake Claire Park Acquisition Project

Lake Claire Park is nestled at the far eastern edge of the city limits but at the heart of what makes Atlanta different- a modern metropolis in the midst of a temperate rain forest. Although it seems off the radar of larger city issues, the budget cuts and economic woes have left us with the need for stewardship and improvements to come from the community itself. Lake Claire Park needs your help to expand and protect the biological corridor and watershed that runs through the park. The land acquisition to expand the park is in jeopardy unless you help.

Funding Goal: \$50,000

- Increase size of park by 18%
- Protect a link in the biological corridor that extends through the Frazer Center property, the Olmsted Linear Parks, the Fernbank Forest and protected areas of woods on Emory's campus
